Background

Over the past three years, the Sherman Inlet Technical Steering Committee has retained Earth Tech Canada Inc. to perform a series of studies required to develop the detailed revitalization plan components. These studies were funded by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment. Sherman Inlet, located at Pier 15, has been identified as an area for remediation in the Hamilton Port Authority's 2002 Land Use Plan. The objectives of the Sherman Inlet Revitalization are to enhance natural attributes and provide appropriate public access to Sherman Inlet. The level of contamination in the soil, sediment and surface water at this former heavy industrial site has been characterized for the purposes of preparing a draft Risk Assessment. Although these draft reports are still under review we are sharing the key results tonight, and seeking your comments on the findings and next steps.
